



Want to Race?



The **IditaREAD** follows the famous Alaskan dog sled race, **The Iditarod**.
 Race starts **March 2, 2019** and can take 8-20 days depending on the weather.
 There are **1049 miles** in the Iditarod race from Anchorage to Nome, Alaska.
 Do you think your family/team can work together to read 1049 minutes or pages
 before your opposing dog sled team finishes the race?

Here's How to Play:

1. Decide whether to keep track of minutes or pages as a family.
2. Select a real dog sled team to race against from the back of this sheet.
3. Completely fill out form at bottom. If you include your email address, we will send fun facts and updates from the race.
4. Return the form to the public library or to your school office.
5. After registering, you will receive a chart with paw prints. This is how you track your progress.
6. Begin recording your reading on March 2, 2019. Color in one paw print for every 10 minutes/10 pages read. (Reading aloud as a family counts for each family member!)
7. Return your completed chart to the Waupaca Area Public Library.

All children whose families have completed the race will win a free book. Prizes must be selected at the library by April 1st.
