III. Exhibit Room Report by Liz Kneer

- 1. The J. Krosoczka author visit went well and was well attended. Attendance = 1522 for this short exhibit.
- The Youth Art Month exhibit attendance was 1878. There has been talk to make this exhibit longer in the future. One month is a short amount of time for much work to get the student art displayed.
- 3. The current exhibit is Our Town, Your Future. It will run from April 6- May 25 and includes the history of Waupaca, plans for the future of Waupaca as well as information on the 25 years of the new library.
- 4. Liz Kneer has been notified that she was awarded a grant from the American Library Association (ALA) for an exhibit called 'Thinking Money for Kids' in 2020. This will be a free

exhibit, with free training for Liz at the ALA convention in Washington DC and a \$1000 stipend. Waupaca was one of two libraries in Wisconsin to get this grant, the other library is in Milwaukee.

5. The library is looking for a future author to bring to Waupaca for 2020 or 2021. J. Krosoczka was such a success in 2019.

IV. Treasurer's Report - by Jim Olsen, Treasurer

Current total of Foundation funds = \$122,063.45

Community Foundation total = \$53,788.67

Our initial investment in the Community Foundation was \$50,000. We recently experienced a loss of \$4,721.15 because the stock market was down. We have the ability to take \$5582.84 from the Community Foundation account this year.

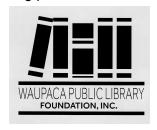
